VISALIA MAN FOUND GUILTY OF CHILD MOLESTATION

Yesterday in Department 5 of the Tulare County Superior Court, Visalia Division, Judge Joseph Kalashian presiding, a Tulare County jury found Larry Sul, age 64, of Visalia, guilty of child molestation.

Sul was convicted of two counts of forcible lewd act upon a child under the age of 14, and four counts of lewd act upon a child under the age of 14. Each count is a felony. Sul admitted to having two prior strike convictions for assault with a deadly weapon and robbery, as well as four prior prison terms.

The crimes occurred between 2013 and 2015 in Tulare County against a single minor victim.

Sentencing is set for June 7, 2017, in Tulare County Superior Court where Sul faces up to 162 years to life in state prison.

The case was prosecuted by Deputy District Attorney Laura Jackson of the Crimes against Children Division and investigated by Katherine Porter of the District Attorney's Bureau of Investigations.
